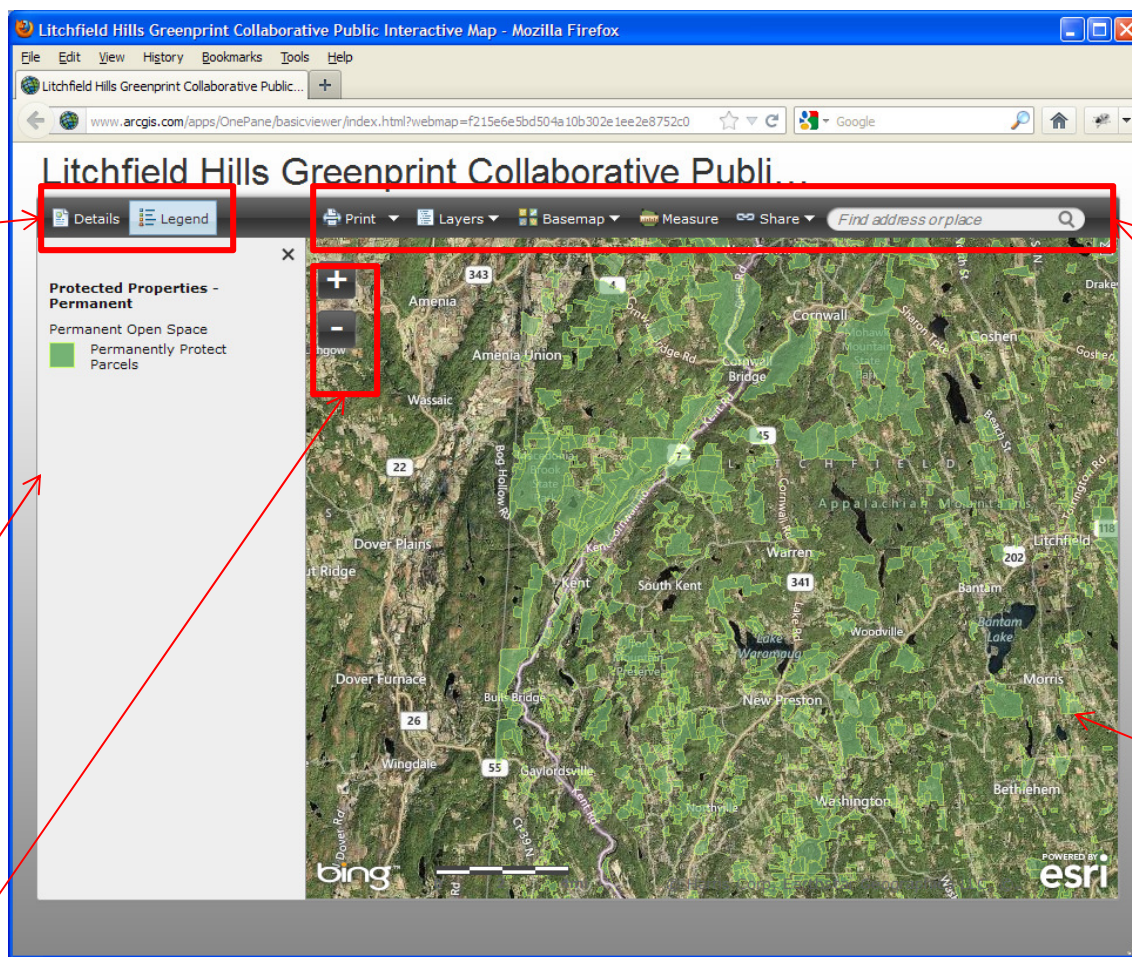


# GREENPRINT INTERACTIVE MAP USER GUIDE



Legend and Details Tabs

Left pane

Zoom in & out

Map viewer window

- **Legend and Details Tabs:** These Tabs show information about the map. When the Legend Tab is selected the **Left Pane** shows the names and symbols of the Layers that are turned on. The Details Tab gives a text description of the interactive mapping portal.
- **Left Pane:** This pane shows the content of the Legend and Details Tabs. The **Left Pane** can be closed by left-clicking on the “x” in the upper right corner. If you close the **Left Pane** you can reopen it by left-clicking on either **Legend** or **Details**.
- **Zoom in & out:** The plus sign button zooms in the map and the minus sign button zooms out.
- **Toolbar:** The **Toolbar** contains a number of tools for interacting with the map.
  - The **Print** button allows the user to print the screen.
  - The **Layers** button allows users to turn layers on and off.
  - The **Basemaps** button allows the user to choose the map background, the options include aerial images and topographic maps.
  - The **Measure** tool allows users to measure polygons, lines, or find the coordinates of points.
  - The **Share** tool allows the user to share this map on social networks.
  - The **Search** tool allows the user to type in an address and find that location on the map.
- **Map Viewer Window:** This window is where the interactive map is displayed showing the used-selected layers and basemap. In the upper right-hand corner of the map is an arrow, when that arrow is clicked it opens an overview map that shows where the **Map Viewer Window** is centered.
- **Toolbar:** The **Toolbar** contains a number of tools for interacting with the map. The **Print** button allows the user to print the screen. The **Layers** button allows users to turn layers on and off. The **Basemaps** button allows the user to choose the map background, the options include aerial images and topographic maps. - **Map Controls:** This map is designed to allow the user to control what they see in a very simple manner.
  - **Panning:** by left-clicking and dragging the **Map Viewer Window** the user can move the center of the map.
  - **Zooming:** the user can zoom in and out by clicking the plus and minus signs in the upper left-hand corner, rolling the mouse wheel, and double-clicking the mouse.
  - **Pop-ups:** for some map layers you can left-click on features and a pop-up window will display more detailed information about that feature.
